FYS 11: FIRST YEAR SEMINAR  
SPRING SEMESTER 2022  
FOR: HIGH SCHOOL SOPHOMORES ONLY  
ONLINE APPLICATION**

**FYS 11: FIRST YEAR SEMINAR (1 credit)** is a one-credit seminar that prepares students for college and career exploration. The goal of FYS 11 is to help students learn skills and strategies needed to be successful in college. During the course of the semester, students will develop self-awareness, academic skills, and good habits such as time management, planning for the future, and communication skills. Classes will meet remotely one day per week (Tuesday or Wednesday or Thursday from 5:00 – 6:30 pm). **The FYS 11 course is offered through the Bronx Community College Now Program, since the Lehman College Now program does not have a 1 credit course appropriate for high school sophomores.**

**Eligibility:**

- Student must be a NYC Public HS Student in 10<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Student must have an overall HS average of 80+.
- Student must have access to a desktop or laptop computer.

The application process is a two-step procedure. Please follow the directions below.

**Step 1:**

- Go to: <http://www.bcc.cuny.edu/academics/student-success-programs/collegenow/application/>
- Select **New Student**
- Fill in contact information (name, last, home address, email address, phone number)
- Under High School name, check box **“my high school is not listed”**
- Type in your full high school name
- Select Grade level
- Go to first choice class: Select **FYS Lehman**
- Upload transcript (Students do not need to upload PSAT or SAT scores)
- At the bottom of the page, Click **“Go to step 2”**

**Step 2:**

Complete the BCC CUNYfirst online application. We recommend students complete the application in one sitting.

- Click **“go to CUNYfirst”**
- Select register now, create username and password. Fill in all required information. Submit.
