- I understand my child will be participating outdoors for soccer while the Real Feel/Wind Chill Temperature is, or above, 42° F. My child will dress accordingly. For soccer, while not dangerous activities, are strenuous low-contact sports that may, on occasion, cause injuries.
- I authorize the coaches to act for me in the best interest of my child in any situation, including, but not limited to, medical emergencies.
- I agree to hold participants, coaches, RKA, New York City Public Schools, and New York City Parks & Recreation harmless from any liability that may arise from normal participation in these sports.
- Participants must meet and adhere to academic and behavioral requirements set forth by the NYCPS Code of Conduct and RKA guidelines.
- Students will meet in the cafeteria at 2:40 pm each session. All equipment must be brought to school. They are not allowed to leave the building and come back. Students will be dismissed at 4:40 pm via the main entrance.

SOCCER TOURNAMENT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do students need special equipment to participate?

A: Yes. Students will need to supply their own sneakers and shin guards. Please do not wear cleats of any kind, as they may injure others and damage the grass field. **Crocs or rubber sandals/slides are strictly forbidden, and students will not be allowed to wear them during the activity.**

Q: Do students need to participate in every session?

A: While students may have prior commitments, they should make every effort to attend regularly.

Q: What happens if a student is already involved with RNH or another club?

A: Students enrolled in other activities may still participate in the tournament. Please be mindful that RNH students will miss their Homework Help sessions and may have to complete remaining homework at home.

Q: What is the cost for participation?

A: **Students will pay for the tournament using the point balance in their Tiger Tokens PBIS Rewards app or website. The cost of the tournament is 15 Tiger Tokens.**

Q: How are teams selected?

A: Drills and training sessions will allow instructors to evaluate participants and place them on appropriately leveled teams. Coaches will obtain feedback from players to ensure balanced teams and competition.

Q: Are there other sports?

A: We will offer other tournaments as they become available (basketball, flag football, ultimate frisbee). Notice of other sports will be emailed prior to the tournament.

Q: How and where can the permission form be submitted?

A: Students can hand deliver their permission forms to Ms. Prado-Romero in Room 109. Electronic forms will not be accepted.

Q: Where do students meet?

A: All students will report to the cafeteria at 2:40 pm. They will have an opportunity to eat a hot meal for free.

Q: Will my child have phone/device access?

A: For the duration of the activity, phones will be stored in Yondr pouches, just like the regular school day. Pouches will be unlocked at the end of the activity for students leaving the building. Devices of RNH students will remain pouched until their dismissal at 5:40.
