



Electronics Policy

In order to promote intellectual engagement and maintain a wholesome and productive environment, the following will be implemented:

- Personal wi-fi devices including laptops, headphones, watches, and cell phones are not permitted
- School chromebooks will be used in class only

- Cell phones, watches, earbuds are to be placed in a Yondr pouch upon entry.
