Supply List 2026-27

In order to encourage student organization and to minimize costs to families, we have adopted a school-wide supply list. This will make the expectations across the school consistent, and we hope it will also lighten the book bags too! Supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year; quantities provided are the numbers needed to start the year.

***Please keep extra supplies AT HOME. DO NOT send everything into RKA. Because students change rooms throughout the day, the extra supplies are stored at home. Students should bring what they need each day.

- Yondr pouch with ID Card (Distributed on first day of school)
 - 2 x 3 ring binders (2-3 inches)
 - Pocket folders (6 to start)
 - Notebook Dividers (approximately 8) (for example, Avery Model # 11903)
 - Loose leaf paper with holes punched (8 1/2 x 11), for use throughout the year, at least 1,000 sheets to start . Keep most at home, and put some in the 3 ring binder.
 - Graph paper composition books
 - Portable hole punch that fits into the binder (for example, Staples Model #20545)
 - #2 Pencils (3 boxes to start). Bring a few pencils everyday.
 - Blue and black ball point pens (3 boxes to start). Bring a few pens everyday.
 - Colored pencils (24 pack) for art, science and math (1 box to start)
 - Ruler
 - Calculator
 - o Grades 6 and 7 and 8th grade math: Texas instruments TI 34 Multi View
 - o Grades 9-12 PLUS 8th Grade students enrolled in Algebra: Texas Instruments TI-84 plus
- ***Very Important. This is the calculator used throughout HS.
- Post-Its- several packages (at least 5 to start). Bring a pad to school.
 - Highlighters
 - Index Cards
 - Backpack or book bag
 - Planner (suggested so that students can write down assignments)
 - Combination lock for hallway locker (grades 7-12)

****Students in general will not be issued a device to bring back and forth to school.*

Rather, students will have access to devices in RKA as classwork requires. At home assignments may be completed using personal devices or phones, and for those students who do not have access to devices paper

assignments will be available. Families who are able to should consider the purchase of a dedicated wi-fi enabled device (ie Chromebook, laptop, desktop) for use OUTSIDE of school.
