We are excited to announce our annual 7th grade field trip to Philadelphia! This trip is a great way for the students to explore in person the historical topics they have been covering in their 7th grade history classes all year. During this fieldtrip, we will be visiting The Liberty Bell, The Betsy Ross House, and The Museum of the American Museum. Students will be able to see firsthand how our country was built.



- The Liberty Bell is an iconic symbol of American independence
- The Betsy Ross House is a landmark in Philadelphia said to be the site where the seamstress and flag-maker Betsy Ross lived when she sewed the first American Flag.
- From the early stirrings of unrest in Boston to the opening shots of the War of Independence, and from signing of the Declaration of Independence to the creation of the American Republic, the Museum's core exhibition explores the ideas, events, and legacies of America's revolutionary beginnings.
- Time permitting students will take a tour of the National Mint and see where our coins are printed!

The cost of the fieldtrip is \$45.00 and it covers the coach buses to and from Philadelphia and the price of admission for all sites. Money and permission slips are due April 18th, 2019. ***Students will need to bring a bagged lunch.*** We will be picnicking on the lawn in front of the Liberty Bell.
