Supply List 2020-21

In order to encourage student organization and to minimize costs to families, we have adopted a school-wide supply list. This will make the expectations across the school consistent, and we hope it will also lighten the book bags too! Supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year; quantities provided are the numbers needed to start the year.

For Blended students many materials (marked with an asterisk) must be brought back and forth to school on attendance days. For cleaning purposes they cannot be left in the classrooms.

Families of 100% Remote and Blended students should prepare a section of the home for their child to work and store materials.

- Cushioned case for device, **devices must be brought back and forth to school each day.** [Click here to request a device if each of your children does not have a portable device to bring to schools on "in person" days.](#) *
- Headphones with a 3.5 mm jack *
- Hand sanitizer *
- Mask *
- 3 ring binder *
- Pocket folders *
- Notebook Dividers (approximately 8) (for example, Avery Model # 11903)*
- Loose leaf paper with holes punched (8 1/2 x 11), for use throughout the year, at least 1,000 sheets to start . keep most at home, adn put some in binder. *
- Graph paper with holes punched (8 1/2 x 11) for use throughout the year, at least 200 sheets to start
- Portable hole punch that fits into the binder (for example, Staples Model #20545)*
- #2 Pencils (3 boxes to start). Bring a few pencils everyday.*
- Blue and black ball point pens (3 boxes to start). Bring a few pens everyday.*
- Colored pencils (24 pack) for art, science and math (1 box to start)*
- Calculator*
 - Grades 6 and 7: Texas instruments TI 34 Multi View
 - Grades 8-12: Texas Instruments TI-84 plus
- Post its- several packages (at least 5 to start). Bring a pad to school. *
- Highlighters*
- Sketchbook (8 ½ X 11)*
- Cray-Pas Oil Pastels (keep at home until directed)
- Index Cards
- Backpack or book bag*
- Recommended: calendar or organizer where students can write down assignments*
